Student Illness Procedures

DC Health has removed facility guidelines in regards to COVID-19. Should the guidelines be updated DCI will update the procedures for school year 2022-2023 we will continue the following:

Facilities


- Continued use of Ultraviolet Lights in all AHU's
- Continued use of MERV 13 filters
- Step and pull door openers on exterior doors.
- Water fountains not available for use (only bottle fountains).
- Signs posted in student/staff bathrooms to remind students and staff about health hygiene practices
- Continue with routine cleaning. See DCI's <u>cleaning protocol</u>.

Personal Protective Equipment¹

- Masks optional for students and staff while the community levels in DC is low/medium. Students/staff who are identified as close contacts are recommended (Subject to change after survey results).
- Have disposable masks for students/staff at reception, business office, and health suite.
- Masks and gloves required for all food handling and custodial staff
- COVID-19 rapid tests available to students and staff on demand

Student Illness Procedures

- Students head directly to nurse suite
- Nurse will determine whether the student needs to be tested in the A wing health suite by the Patient Care Technician.
- If a student tests negative
 - They can return to class if they feel well enough.
 - o They can be picked up by a parent for dismissal.



- o They can leave campus on their own (with parent permission).
- If a student tests positive
 - They will be sent to the isolation room until parents arrive for dismissal
 - Students will need to isolate themselves at home for at least 5 days. Health and safety team will follow up with isolation instructions.
 - Close contacts will be notified after contact tracing per DC Health guidelines.
